

# English (KG-II) Teacher Guide (Letter Bb)

### **Student Learning Outcome (SLO):**

By the end of the session, the students will be able to:

- Answer the questions by listening the story carefully.
- Recognize the name, sound and graphical representation of the letter "b".
- Pronounce the words starting with the letter "b" correctly.
- Identify the images which are starting with the letter "b"

#### Overview:

The main purpose of this lesson is to make the students memorize the letter and sound of letter Bb

#### **Activities:**

- To brain storm the students, take a balloon in the classroom ask some question about it
  - ➤ What is it?
  - What is the colour of balloon?
  - > Do you like to play with balloon?

### **Development**

Model Reading & Methodology:

- Tell the students that we are going to learn English alphabet.
- Explain them that we are going to read the second letter "b".



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- Show them the flash cards of the letter "b" and introduce its sound "bee".
- Explain them the initial sound in the name of 'ball' is / b /.
- Show them a 'ball' flash card and instruct the children to say the name of the picture, i.e. 'ball' and emphasize the first sound / b /.
- Instruct the children to look carefully at the pages of 'b' on the textbook. Then turn your finger on 'b' five to seven times.
