Activities:

- To brain storm the students, take a cap in the classroom ask some question about it
 - What is it?
 - What is the colour of the cap?
 - Have you ever worn a cap?

Development

Model Reading & Methodology:

- Tell the students that we are going to learn English alphabet.

- Explain them that we are going to read the third letter “c”.
- Show them the flash cards of the letter “c” and introduce its sound “see”.
- Explain them the initial sound in the name of ‘cat’ is / c /.
- Show them a ‘cat’ flash card and instruct the children to say the name of the picture, i.e. ‘cat’ and emphasize the first sound / c /.
- Show the children the name and sound of the letter ‘c’ by using the flash cards.
- Instruct the children to look carefully at the pages of ‘c’ on the textbook
